- ✓ **EXPERT FACILITATION.** Each Peer Learning Community is facilitated by a proven expert in the relevant area. The facilitator serves as a guide to the group in terms of setting topics for discussion and organizing the time efficiently.
- ✓ **JOB-EMBEDDED PROJECTS.** Each participant defines one to three job-embedded development projects to pursue over the course of the year. PLC sessions include opportunities for peer feedback and accountability.
- ✓ **PEER PROBLEM-SOLVING.** Every Peer Learning Community provides participants with the opportunity to share best practices and raise problems of practice with peers in order to illuminate potential solutions.
- ✓ **REGULAR TOUCHPOINTS.** Every PLC meets monthly during business hours. The group dives deeply into themes over the course of the year to build both a broad knowledge base as well as depth of understanding in the core components of the functional area.
